

HORSE TEMPERATURE CHART

- Horse temperatures are to be taken twice per day and recorded in the chart below.
- This sheet may be placed on the horse's stall door or kept in a tack room or tack box. The temperature chart must be available for review by the EC Steward(s) upon request for any horse competing under EC rules. The temperature chart must also be available for review by the horse show veterinarian upon request for any horse, whether or not it is competing under EC rules.*
- Any temperature found to be above 38.9°C in a quiet, resting horse is to be reported to the horse show veterinarian.

*Due to the outbreak of EHM (Equine Herpes Myeloencephalopathy) in Manitoba, it is recommended that competitors be proactive by posting the temperature sheet on the horse's stall door so that it can be easily accessed and monitored.
